



# Walking in Massachusetts

## Bradley Palmer State Park in Topsfield

Special tips for this location: The main parking lot is at 40 Asbury Street, Topsfield, There is a fee of \$5.00 per Ma resident car (\$20.00 per non MA resident car) between May 14th through October 30th.

Highlights of this space include: Plan a work event or even a wedding on the Bradley Palmer grounds at the beautiful Willowdale Estate. There is a ½ mile shady crushed stone all accessible path near the Ipswich River. This is a great place for cross country skiing, snowshoeing, snowmobiling, horseback riding, canoeing and kayaking, hiking, biking and fishing!

Hike idea: Make sure to have a print out of the trail map with you before heading out. Check out the map and create a loop as big as you have time for- just make sure to walk to Blueberry Hill and Moon Hill. Or for a suggested hike form the state park, [click here](#)
